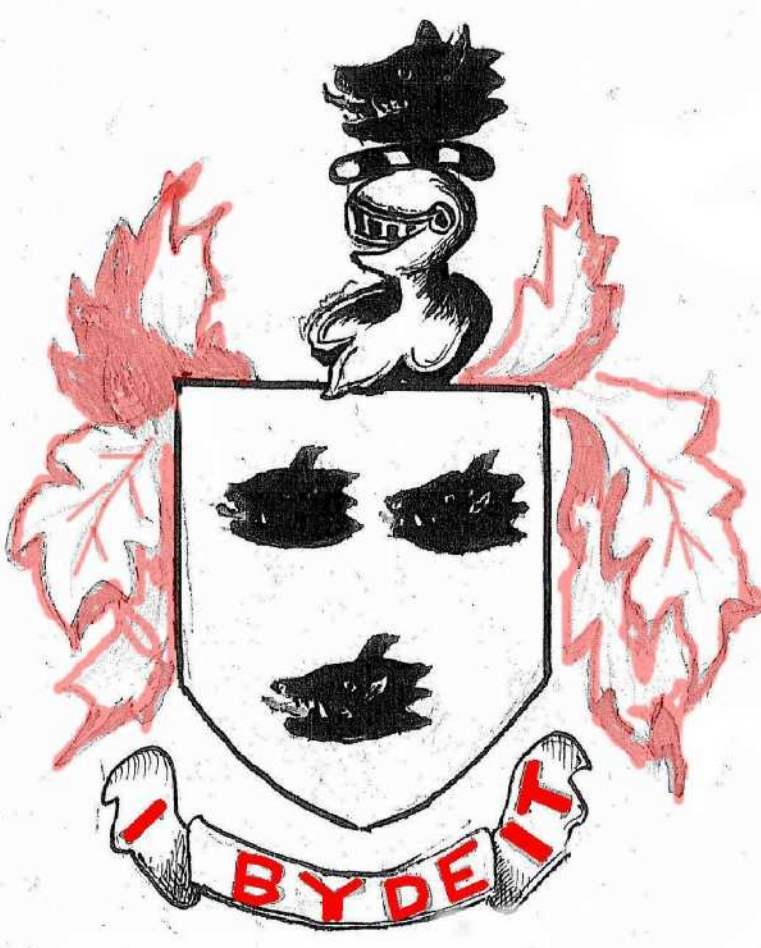
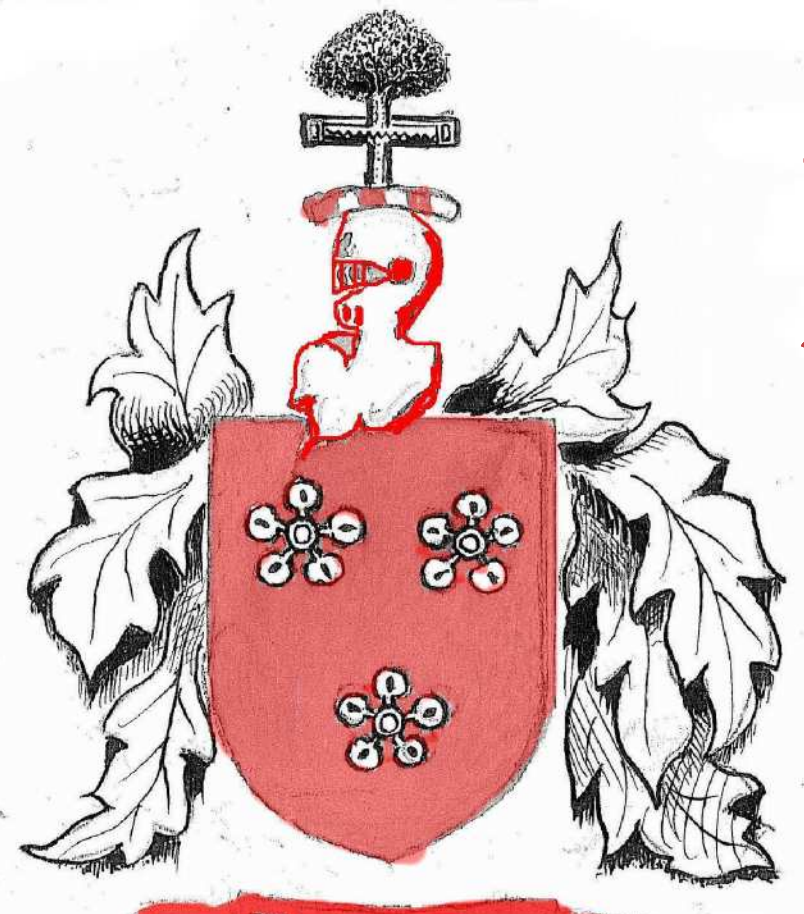


# Pedigree of the Dilbet Family ; otherwise Nisbitt ; latterly called Nesbitt ; deriving from Nesebite (now Nisbet) Berwickshire, (Scotland) ; located subsequently at Dalzell ( Lanarkshire ) ; afterwards at Edinburgh, and in Donegal, Leitrim & Cavan counties (Ireland) .



## Dilbet.

**ADAM.** Of West Nisbet. Laird of Nisbet, Berwickshire. (Scotland). Flourished Anno Domini 1480.  
**PHILIP.** FL. 1522. Married Elene, 2<sup>d</sup> dau of Robert Rutherford, of Clatto, by his wife Margaret, dau. of Sir Simon Glendonwyn of that Ilk.



## Hamilton.

**JAMES.** First Lord HAMILTON. By Janet Calderwood he had:-  
**JOHN.** Natural son. Legitimated January 20, 1513. Of Broomhill. Married Janet, daughter of Robert Hamilton, of Preston. Died. 1526.

**ADAM.** Served heir to his father, 14 May 1523. Mar. Lucie, dau. of George Rutherford, of Hundalee. D. 1530.  
**PHILIP.** Laird of Nisbet.  
**GEORGE.** In 1551 he had charge of Nisbet. In 1563 declared his claim. Sir David N.

**GEORGE.** About 1513 married = **AGNES.** Born about 1494. Her Will was proved 17 November, 1582.  
**(Sir) DAVID.** Born about 1514. In 1543 was Servant (Chaplain, or Secretary) to his Kinsman, the Regent of Scotland, viz: James Hamilton, Earl of Arran, Duke of Châtellherault. Died before 24 May 1561. (See Protocol Book of Gilbert Grege.)  
**JAMES.** Born about 1542. Natural son of Sir David Nisbet. (See Protocol Book of Gilbert Grege.) Educated at University of Paris. In 1567 married Catherine Conroe. Was burgess of Edinburgh June 15, 1574.  
**JOHN.** Born about 1565. In 1587 was Servant (Secretary) to M<sup>r</sup> Archibald Douglas, Scottish Ambassador to the Court of Queen Elizabeth of England. In 1597 married Janet, daughter of late James Bannatyne.

**DAVID.** Of Broomhill. Mar. Margaret, dau. of Robert Master of Semple, Tall at Roske, 1547.  
**JOHN.** Born about 1508. Mar. Elizabeth Hamilton, of Ualston. D. 1594.

## NISBITT.

**(Captain) JOHN.** Born 1623. Of Tully Donnell, Wilson's Fort, Co. Donegal. Served in War in Ireland under Captain William Hamilton. In 1645 married Rebecca, daughter of William Wilson, and sister of Sir John Wilson. Received 1669, (as 1699 Officer) Grant of Donnell & Aghry, (Barony of Mohill) Co. Leitrim. D. 1692. Buried at St. Michaels, Dublin. His Administrators (7 Nov. 1700) were (son) James N. and (nephew) Henry N.  
**(Captain) JAMES.** Born 1646. Married 1<sup>st</sup> about June 1661. Ursula, dau. of Henry Crofton, of Mohill, Co. Leitrim. In 1665 she was slain by rebels in attack upon Aghry Castle. Married 2<sup>nd</sup> about May 1691. Prudence (nee Catharine, or Conon), relict of Matthew Cokayne, of Roske, Co. Donegal. She died Inverata, 1708, of July, Donnell. In March 1712, the Estate of Tully Donnell was sold for 60000 to William Montgomery of Glasgow. D. 1724.  
**(Major) JOHN.** Born about 1681. Of Donnell, Co. Leitrim. Mar. before July 1701. Prudence, dau. of Matthew Cokayne. She died Aug. 1742. Buried at St. Michaels, Dublin. He died 1730. Born about 1686. D. Int. 1745. Off. in the Army of France.

**JAMES.** Born 1598. Of Edinburgh. Married 1622 Catherine Gray.

## NISBITT.

**HENRY.** Born about 1625. Mar. Lic. Feb 9 1658. To Grisel Riddell, daughter of John Riddell, of Munlozie, by his second wife Grisel, daughter of Patrick Shaw, Minister of St. Kier's, and his wife Katherine Mitchell. D. Oct. 1658. She died Jan. 1659.  
**HENRY.** Born in Edinburgh, 1658. Attorney, of Dublin. On 7<sup>th</sup> November 1700, jointly with Captain James Nisbitt, signed bond for £1000 as Administration of Estate of late Captain John Nisbitt. In 1709 made Trustee of Estate of Captain James Nisbitt.  
**HENRY.** Born about 1665. Of Donegal. Married July 1712 (License Kilmore Grant Book. Page 84) Jane, daughter of Robert Reader, of Tonagh, parish of Castle Terra, Co. Cavan.

**JOHN.** Of Aghry, Co. Leitrim. Mar. Prudence Reyd. Will dated 2 Jan. 1710. Proved 21 April 1760.

**HENRY, of Aghry. MATHREW. JOHN.** Born about 1713. **NESBITT.** **HENRY.** of Castle Terra. Mar. cir. 1746. of Ballyhaise, Co. Cavan. Born about 1716. Married before 7 B. August 1756 Rhoda, daughter of John Clarke of Bellabulbin, Co. Cavan, by his wife Jane, daughter of Thomas Cokernam. Killed in Aug. 1716.

**GEORGE.** Born about 1718. of Ballyhaise. Mar. about 1756 Rachel, dau. of George Humphrys, and grand-daughter of Thomas Phillips of the Society of Friends.

This Pedigree, created in 1924, by John Nesbitt Dowling attempts to trace his family back to Adam of West Nisbet, circa 1480, in Scotland. A Nesbitt/Nisbet Society of North America member, surnamed Nesbitt and relative of John Nesbitt Dowling participated in an ongoing DNA study, which shows him to be in a different DNA group from the Chief of the Clan. This could reflect a long ago adoption, or a simple error in the Pedigree. The Society member can, however trace his family to Edinburgh, Scotland in the 1600s.
